

UMCOR School Kit

- 1 pair blunt scissors—round tip
NO plastic
- 3 pads of paper—spiral or top bound
150 sheets or less of loose leaf may be substituted for one pad
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
at least 1 inch long—remove packaging
- 1 30-centimeter ruler
NO advertising, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols
- 1 2 inches or larger eraser
NO advertising, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols
- 1 box of 24 count crayons
- 1 14" x 16" cloth bag
 - Purchased or made of heavy fabric such as denim, corduroy or drapery
 - OPTIONAL closure (Velcro, snaps or buttons) must be sewn opening center
 - NO advertising, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols

Assembly Directions

PLACE all loose items on top of paper;
TURN sideways & slide into cloth bag; and,
FOLD over top of bag to secure items.

Health Kit

- 1 hand towel--15 x 25 inches to 17 x 27 inches
NO kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
 - 1 washcloth
 - 1 sturdy comb—at least 6 inches long
NO pocket combs or picks
 - 1 metal nail file or nail clippers
 - 1 bath-size soap--3 oz. and larger sizes only
NO Ivory or Jergens soap
Do not remove from original packaging.
 - 1 toothbrush -- adult size only;
Do not remove from original packaging.
 - 6 adhesive bandages -- ¾ inch to 1 inch
Common household Band-Aids
 - 1 plastic bag – 1 gallon size sealable bag only
- \$1.00 to purchase toothpaste**

Assembly Directions

Set the \$1.00 for toothpaste aside to be included in a separate envelope.
Lay out the hand towel flat on a table.
Lay the washcloth flat in the center of the hand towel.
Place all remaining items on top of the washcloth.
Fold over the sides of the hand towel to cover all of the items. Fold over one end of the hand towel so that it covers all of the items.
Grasp the bundle of items tightly and roll over the remainder of the hand towel tightly.
Place the tightly rolled bundle in the plastic bag.
Remove as much air as possible and seal the bag.

Important Notes

- All items must be new and unwashed!
- Remove packaging unless otherwise noted.

UMCOR is now purchasing toothpaste in bulk to be added to health kits before shipping to ensure that the product does not expire before they are sent. ***Do not put single dollar bills in each kit.*** Collect all money for toothpaste, then ***place it in a separate envelope and send along with the kit donations.***

Birthing Kit

1 small bar of soap— 1 - 2 oz. size

*Do not remove from original packaging;
small "hotel size" bars are acceptable.*

1 pair thin gloves — Surgical, latex, or

thin rubber gloves are acceptable

1 square yard of clear plastic sheeting

Must be 4 mil thick;

NO plastic trash bags or shower curtains

3 12-inch long pieces of cotton string

*Must be clean; secure the pieces of string by
bundling and tying them together;
NO yarn please.*

1 single-edge razor blade

*Must be covered in paper or cardboard;
NO regular shaving razors*

2 receiving blankets

*28 x 28 to 32 x 32 inches each;
NO thermal or fleece blankets*

1 gallon-size plastic sealable bag

Assembly Directions

- ◇ Fold the plastic sheeting and blankets so they will fit easily into the plastic bag.
- ◇ Lay the loose items on top of the blankets and plastic sheeting.
- ◇ Slide all items into the plastic bag.
- ◇ Squeeze as much air out of the bag as possible and then seal it.

Layette Kit

Please do NOT prewash any items!!!

6 cloth diapers -- prefolded or plain

NO disposable diapers

2 shirts -- undershirts or onsies

2 infant washcloths

NO adult washcloths

2 gowns or sleepers

2 diaper pins

Must have protective plastic closures;
NO regular safety pins

1 sweater or jacket – front opening

*May be hand knitted, crocheted, or sewn;
hooded sweatshirts are acceptable.*

2 receiving blankets

*Sizes may range from
28x28 inches to 32x32 inches;
NO crib blankets.*

Assembly Directions

Lay one of the receiving blankets flat on a table.

Set aside the diaper pins and place all remaining items on top of the blanket.

Fold the blanket around the items and secure the bundle with the diaper pins.

Sewing Kit

3 continuous yards of fabric

Cotton or cotton blend only

NO heavy duty, corduroy, knit, etc.;

*NO patriotic, religious, holiday, camouflage, or
military patterned fabric.*

1 pair fabric scissors

1 package hand sewing needles

in original packaging

1 medium to large spool of thread

NO travel kit thread, please.

5 to 8 buttons -- 5/8-inch size or larger

No loose buttons;

*Leave buttons in original packaging or
fasten all together.*

1 plastic one-gallon sealable bag

Assembly Directions

Place kit in the plastic bag and seal.
