Fairway District UMM 2022 Scholarship Application

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICATION

Scholarship awards in amounts to be determined by the FDUMM will be provided to those young men deemed most deserving by the Scholarship Selection Committee from the applications received by the FDUMM on or before *July 8*, *2022*.

Award payment will be made:

- a) Directly to the school (College, Graduate or Trade School) the award recipient will attend during the 2022-23 academic year or
- b) Directly to the award recipient for book costs upon production of a receipt and proof of book requirement by school or teacher

The following guidelines apply to the FDUMM Scholarship:

- 1) Eligibility is limited to males who have completed high school and who will be less than 25 years old as of July 8, 2022.
- 2) Applicants must be attending a College, Graduate or Trade School, which is fully accredited, during the 2022-23 academic year (applicant must provide a copy of a Letter of Acceptance or a Certification of Enrollment).
- 3) Applicants must be a member of, or regularly attend, a United Methodist Church in the Fairway District of the North Carolina Conference that has a currently chartered (2022) United Methodist Men's Ministry.
- 4) The applicant's church or UMM Ministry must contribute at least \$150 to the Fairway District UMM Scholarship Fund prior to June 30, 2022.
- 5) A completed application must be submitted to FDUMM (<u>Bill Huggins</u>, 1495 <u>Kentucky Ave., Sanford, NC 27332 or sanhug@gmail.com</u>) by July 8, 2022.
- 6) An applicant must also submit <u>current (2022)</u> reference letters from: his Pastor, the UMM President of his Church and from a current (2021-22 academic year) school administrator or teacher/professor (these letters may be submitted directly to Mr. Huggins (by mail or email) by the person writing the letter).
- 7) An applicant must furnish a certified transcript of his full academic record from his most recently attended school (the transcripts may be submitted directly to Mr. Huggins by the school).

Past scholarship recipients are eligible for a 2022 scholarship award. However, there is no preferential treatment for those previously selected.
