

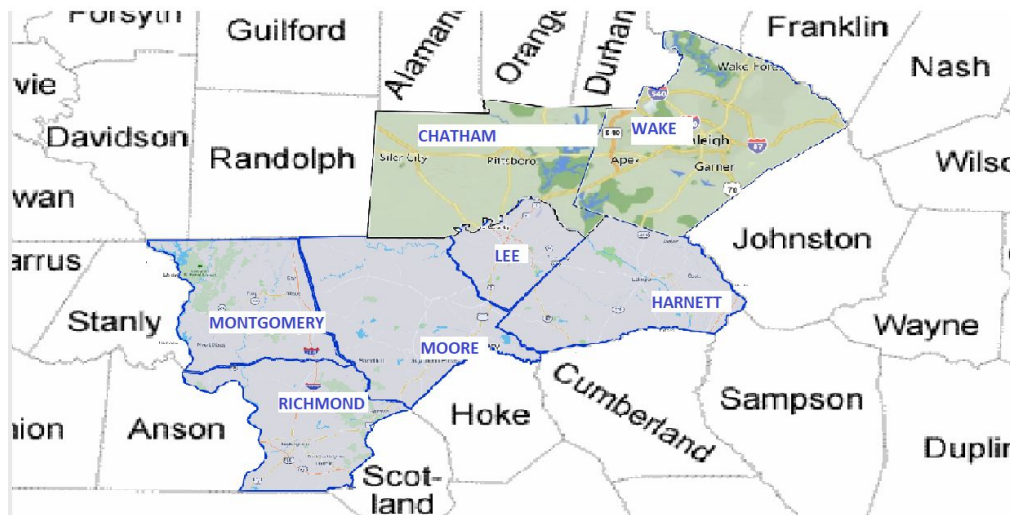


Fiesta Cristiana

Two primary support service programs

- Family Resource Center - Focusing on Western Wake and exploring supporting the other counties in the District
 - Community Health Worker
 - Food distribution and help with basic needs
 - Family support programming
 - Tutoring school age children
 - Youth development
- Community Health Workers
 - Lee, Harnett, Moore, Montgomery and Richmond since October 2021
 - Reaching historically marginalized populations including those marginalized because of language
 - Connects communities with COVID -19 related resources including Spanish education material, testing/contact, tracing, primary care, vaccination, and support services, assistance
 - Food distribution



CHW Approach

- **FC as a resource available to collaborate** Collaboration with other communities resource ex Food pantry, town of Vass vaccination program hub for farm workers.
- **Meeting hispanic/latino people where they are** finding, teach and connect with families and individuals in their own language and on site door to door in housing communities, mobile home parks, neighborhoods, businesses interpret and translate for families and individuals that have a language barrier.
- **Safety first** prepare and gave personal protective equipment to keep everyone safe, educate and give educational materials regarding Covid and other health aspects.

Family Resource Center

- 500 individuals received Covid19 vaccinations at events hosted or organized by the Family
- 4,160 individuals assisted with food also received COVID19 Spanish information, PPE, and testing kits (as available). 4,160 people from across Western Wake County received food through distribution events organized by the Family Resource Center.
- 27 families received financial assistance for utilities and basic needs with \$15,000 invested directly.
- 66 children in grades K-8 received tutoring through the year.
- 36 families with children under the age of five participated in our parenting classes through our
- Building Family Support programs (Circle of Parents and Paternidad Efectiva).
